- **Membership Renewals now due for 2019.** Dues are \$12 per year for individuals, \$20 for a household, go toward the expenses and projects of the Association and are tax deductible. (We are a 501(c)(3) nonprofit corporation.) Please fill out the application form (below).
- **Emergency home repairs:** If you qualify, the city has contracted with Christmas in Action (CIA), a volunteer non-profit, to provide emergency home repairs, such as wheelchair ramps and structural or systems repairs. You must be a homeowner and meet income, age, or disability requirements. Applications are available at <http://www.ciaspartanburg.org> or call 576-7101. Repairs will be made by teams of volunteers or by licensed contractors, depending on the complexity of the needed repairs.
- **Christmas in Action is also interested in volunteers** who can work on projects, preferably as a team from neighborhoods or organizations, but individuals will be assigned to work with established teams. Also, if you are a licensed contractor you can apply to be pre-approved for more complex projects funded by the city. Habitat for Humanity has started a similar program but only in the neighborhoods where it is currently working.

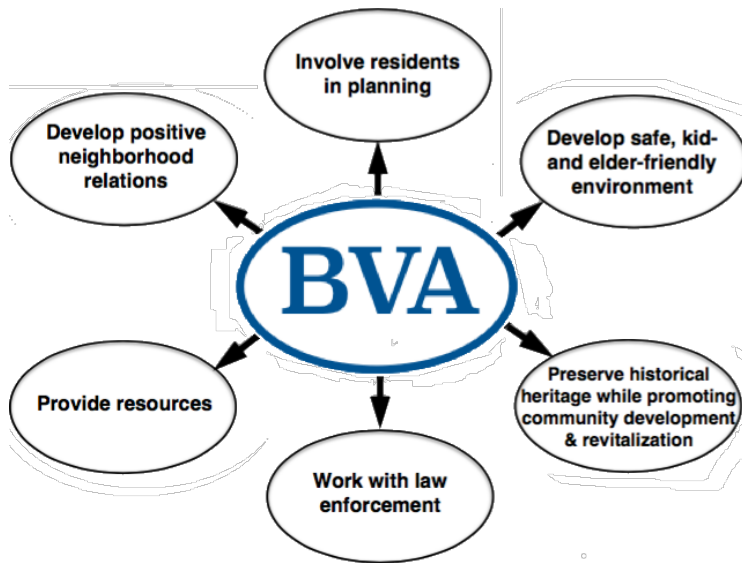
