- **It's official: Beaumont is getting a children's playground!** You may have seen the one-line announcement in the *Herald Journal Weekly* article last week. The city is partnering with a non-profit called KaBoom! ("Play matters for all children") to design and build a park at "the triangle," the vacant lot at Beaumont Avenue and Southern Street.
- **Neighborhood Park Design Meeting—
Beaumont Mill/ SRHS, Wednesday, July 31.**
Use the back entrance (Employee Dining Area). KaBoom!, the organization working with the city to build our park, involves residents in designing and building parks all over the country. **Children's Design Session, 4PM:** all kids present will have the chance to draw their dream playground. The drawings will be used as inspiration for the final playground design. **Adults' Planning Meeting, 5 PM:** Community support is essential to making this project a success. Attendees will learn more about working with KaBOOM! and have the opportunity to sign up to be on the planning committee for the playground Build Day. They will also use the children's drawings to help pick out playground equipment and colors for the new custom playground.

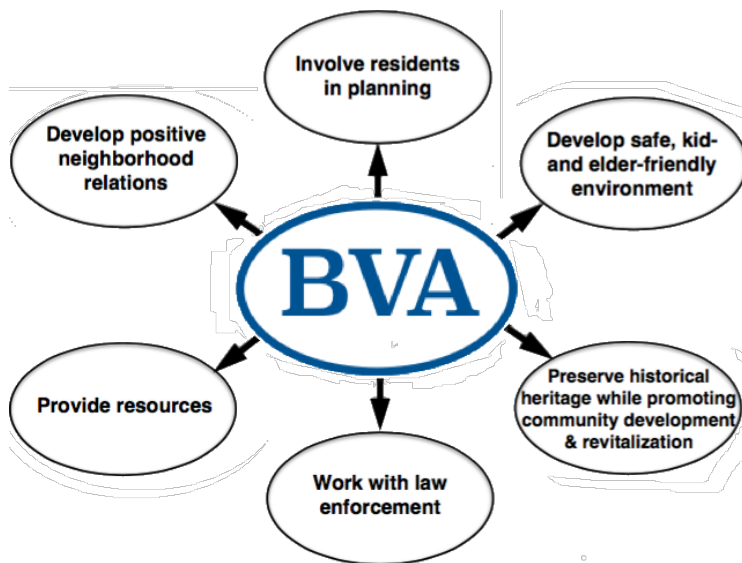
