Low income residents who have been homeowners for at least 2 years can apply for help with things like siding/roofing repair, installation of safety railings, etc. The application takes 6 months and applicants must be current on mortgage & tax payments and be able to provide 10% of the cost. 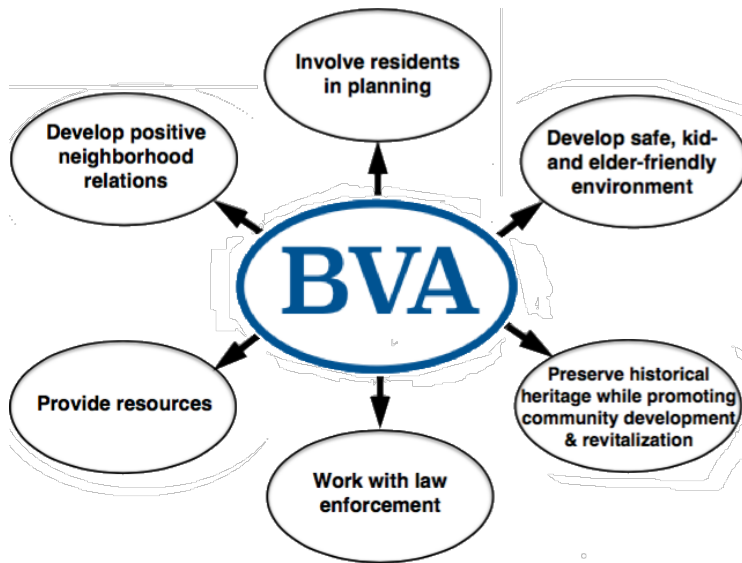
